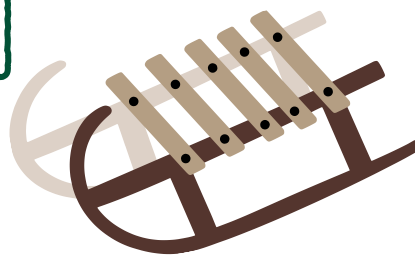

Monthly Theme

This January, our infant classroom will be exploring winter through gentle, sensory-based activities designed to support development, curiosity, and engagement.

Week 1: A Winter Wonderland

We will introduce winter through soft colors, cozy textures, and simple sensory experiences. Infants will explore winter-themed visuals, books, and materials while engaging in tummy time, reaching, and grasping activities that promote motor development.

Week 2: Penguins

During penguin week, infants will explore animal recognition through books, songs, and visuals.

They will also participate in a penguin coloring activity using infant-safe materials, allowing them to explore colors and textures while strengthening fine motor skills.

Week 3: Ice Skating

Throughout the month, we will continue to nurture social connections, language development, and milestone growth while making winter learning fun and engaging for our littlest learners!

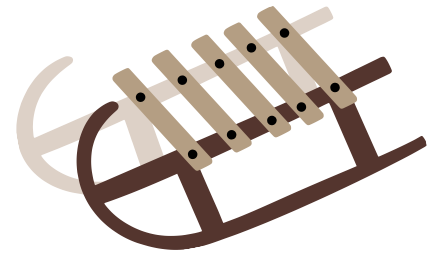
INFANT ROOM STAR STUDENT

Week 2: Snowmen

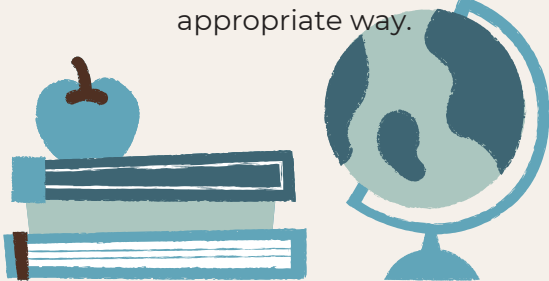

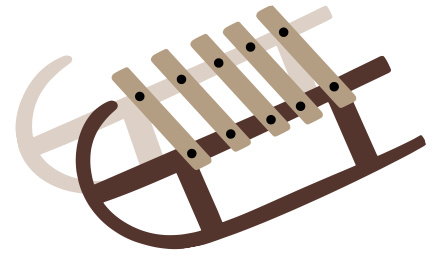

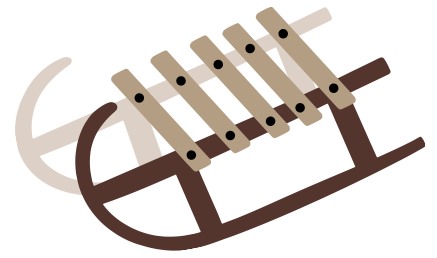

Monthly Theme
